

Excursion Boats Travel in the Deepest Part of the River, the River Channel.

It is marked on this map by the deeper blue line. Note it swings from bank to bank in the river. Originally the channel was dredged for barges. Barges move best in straight lines. Therefore the channel links long sections straight line travel with turning points.

Excursion Boats Come Very Close to Shore Midway Btw Franklin & the RR Bridge. Rowers should pass on the river side of excursion boats in this area.

Excursion Boats Travel Close to Shore Around this Corner. Rowers should stay toward the middle of the river when meeting the excursion boats at this corner

Stay out from shore in this area. Many deadheads.
